Alex C. Chen, U.S. Marine Corps veteran, died on Sunday, June 26, 2022, in Bend, Oregon. He was 37.

He was born on June 8, 1985, in Houston, TX, at Memorial City General Hospital, where his sister was also born. He is survived by his sister and mother. He was preceded in death by his father.

Alex enjoyed the outdoors and sitting around campfires with friends and family and loved playing video games as well. His friends said that he had an adventurous spirit. He earned a degree in accounting from a local community college after moving to Bend. Alex is remembered as a diligent and dependable hard worker who was very clever. When he was young, his mother once told him to eat his fish since it would make him smarter, to which he replied: "If the fish was so smart, then why did he get caught and eaten? "

He originally served in the U.S. Air Force and then joined the Marine Corps with his initial training at Camp Pendleton, California. After the military, Alex worked in construction, servicing many homes in Oregon.
