



Beatrice Tabke Williams

August 10, 1909 - June 27, 2013

Beatrice Tabke Williams died June 27th, just six weeks shy of her 104th birthday. She was born August 10, 1909 in Portland, OR. Her family relocated to Astoria where Bea attended elementary and high school. Bea is a graduate of the University of Oregon in the field of Education. She married Scott Williams on June 4, 1933 in Roseburg, where she taught music and English. In 1943 the family moved to Corvallis where Bea lived for 65 years. She quickly transferred her loyalty from the Ducks to the Beavers. In 2007 Bea moved to the Bend Villa Retirement Center to be close to family. Bea was an active member of the Episcopal Church her entire life and believed in serving of others. She volunteered at Good Samaritan Hospital in Corvallis as well as serving on the Hospital Foundation for many years. Beatrice was a member of PEO Chapter AR and of the Assistance League in Corvallis. Bridge, gardening, golf and baking were sources of joy for Bea, as was traveling and spending time with family and friends. She is survived by her two children, Peter (Pat) Williams of Orinda, CA and Julieann (Jerry) Lear of Bend; five grandchildren, Bob Williams of Roseburg, Mary (Tom) Williams of Glasgow, Scotland, Kristin Lear of Seattle, Mark (Wendy) Lear of Portland and Kimberlee Lear of Bend. She has six great grandchildren.
