



Charles "Charlie" Wilson III

June 12, 1949 - November 25, 2024

Charles "Charlie" Wilson III was born in Russellville, KY, on June 12, 1949. He passed away on November 25th, 2024, in Bend, OR, at the age of 75. The oldest of five children, Charlie was raised in Bowling Green, KY, by his parents, Lucile and Charles Wilson Jr. He met his soulmate and best friend, Melissa, at Glendale Baptist Church in 1966.

Charlie began his military service as a Military Police Officer in 1969 and married Melissa in 1971. Upon graduating from the University of Tennessee at Chattanooga, he earned a commission as a Second Lieutenant in the Infantry. He served honorably for 23 years, retiring from active duty as a Lieutenant Colonel, and continued his service as a GS-15 with Recruiting and Cadet Commands for nearly 20 more years.

Charlie is survived by his wife of 53 years, Melissa; his children, Jason, Andy, and Kathryn; his sisters, Pat, Lynda, and Joyce; and his grandchildren, Jack, Charlie, Emerson, Ellie, Maddie, Audrey, and Emma. He also leaves behind countless friends who became like family.

Charlie spent half his life traveling the globe in service to his country, but Kentucky was always his true home. He and Melissa lived in Elizabethtown, KY, for more than 20 years. A proud Kentucky Colonel, Charlie was beloved by many for his selflessness, generosity, and steadfast pride in his children and grandchildren. His hobbies included helping anyone in need and sharing stories of his family's accomplishments.

Funeral services will be held at his son Andy's home on Saturday, November

30th. Charlie will be deeply missed but forever cherished by all who knew him.

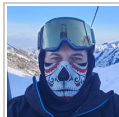

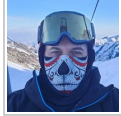

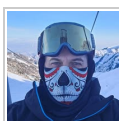
