Shortly after graduation he entered the U.S. Air Force and was stationed in Anchorage, Alaska. Following four years of service he was honorably discharged and returned to Bend. He was employed for a time at Portland Loan Company, and later joined the Employment office for the State of Oregon. Following several years here, he was promoted to manager of the Redmond office, a position he held until retirement at age 66 and over 30 years of service to the State of Oregon. On December 12, 1959 he married Pat Morris in Corvallis and after a short honeymoon returned to Bend. He was active in the community, having been a member of the Bend Jaycees, Benevolent Protective Order of Elks #1371, Lions Club, Deschutes Pioneer Association and for several years served on the Bend Water Peagent Committee and the Bend Parks Recreation Board of directors. Survivors include his wife of 52 years, a sister, Norma Templeton of Chessire, OR, a brother, Ken Bells of Otis, OR. Preceding in death were his parents and brother, Robert. Memorial services will be held, Thursday, March 8th at 1:00 p.m. at Niswonger-Reynolds Chapel.
