In April 21, 1946, she was married in Astoria OR to our father, Robert G. Cusick who passed in 2003. The pair moved often, but soon settled in Bend, OR around 1956. Mom leaves behind her 5 children; Robert, Roger, Ester, Floyd, and Patricia. All of whom call Bend their home. Mom had 10 Grandchildren and 22 great grandchildren that are spread all across these the United States. She was the last to survive of her siblings, and she missed them to the end of her days. As with most people from her time, she was a witness to so many great and horrible events. Including the Great Depression, the loss of her beloved brother, Floyd Addington at Pearl Harbor, and enduring her oldest sons time in Vietnam.
