Jack was responsible for the establishment of the Camp Green Meadows Outdoor School, where hundreds of school children experience the science of the outdoors, the environment, and nature resources each year. Later, the camp was named the Jack L. Boyd Outdoor School in his honor. He was instrumental in the design, development, and completion of the Bend Senior Center. Jack loved life and enjoyed woodworking in his shop (making furniture for family and friends), he also loved to dance, travel and actively participated in community service. Jack attended the Eastmont Church here in Bend. He is survived by his three children, Jack Jr. of LaGrande, Oregon, Jill Donaldson of Princeville, Hawaii, and James of Bonney Lake, Washington, 7 grandchildren and 24 great grandchildren. He is also survived by two sisters, Diane Curran of Idaho and Barbara Profitt of California. A memorial service will be held 10:30 AM on Friday, April 20, 2012 at the Niswonger Reynolds Chapel, 105 NW Irving Ave. Bend, OR.
