James “Keith” Mouser, age 32, passed away on Thursday, February 27, 2025 in Estacada, Oregon.

Keith met Haleigh Cepurno in 2017 and they were involved in a long-term relationship since then. They and Hunter enjoyed many activities together and always included dogs Patsy and Arrow. Keith enjoyed camping, fishing and

bird hunting – always accompanied by family and friends. He enjoyed carpentry and was known to be very kind helping his neighbors with many projects.

Keith was preceded in death by his paternal grandparents, James and Phyllis Mouser.
