Jessie Marie Lynam Petersen was born to Edith and Jess Lynam, September 25, 1918 on her grandparents homestead at Opal Springs, near Culver, OR. Marie died on January 15, 2015 of natural causes, with her family at her side, at Powells Care Home, where she had lived for the past 4 months. Marie married Loyd ("Bud") Petersen of the Pleasant Ridge Community on October 3, 1938. Four children were born to this union. She and Bud owned and operated the Pleasant Ridge Dairy for many years. Marie graduated from Redmond Union High School in 1937 and lived most of her life in the Pleasant Ridge community. She and Bud sold their 40 acre farm in 1990 and moved to Redmond.
