Her favorite TV show was Lawrence Welk and her favorite meal was Mexican.

June and Dick loved their vacation home at Lake Tahoe and spent many weekends and holidays surrounded by Tahoe's natural beauty. Special times at Tahoe included playing card games, working on challenging jigsaw puzzles, and relaxing with family.

Dick passed away on February 2, 2007 due to complications of respiratory pneumonia.

June was active at Aspen Ridge volunteering in the resident store and being a social butterfly. She created many loving friendships.

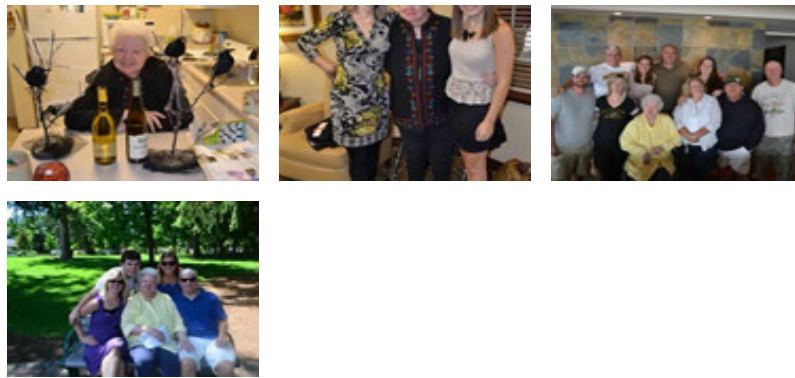
