



## Lloyd "Bud" Brooks

March 12, 1924 - August 5, 2017

Bud Brooks, 93, of Bend, Oregon, passed away at his home, August 5th, 2017, surrounded by his family. Bud was born in Eureka, Kansas to Lloyd and Millie (Franklin) Brooks.
