



## Mary Catherine Westbrook

October 19, 1921 - November 23, 2024

Mary Catherine Westbrook, wife of the late Charles Westbrook, died on November 23, 2024 at the age of 103, in Bend, Oregon.

Mary, the daughter the late Stefan Delinko and Kathryn Pinceakouski, was born in St. Clair

Pennsylvania on August 19, 1921. Orphaned at the age 10, she later left the orphanage to

work in New York City; there, she met her future husband, Charles, who was a member of

the US Marine Corps. Mary was stationed with her husband and their two children at

various Marine Corps facilities in North Carolina, Virginia, Michigan and Puerto Rico.

After Charles's retirement from his military career, Mary and Charles moved to Bastrop,

LA, where they enjoyed a life of hunting, fishing, horse riding and gardening on their large

homestead.
