Raymond J. Buseman Sr. was born in Philadelphia, Pennsylvania on April 30, 1924 to Raymond N. and Esther (Matlock) Buseman. He died January 14, 2014 in Bend, Oregon. Raymond graduated from Glassboro High School, New Jersey in 1943 and from Arizona State University in 1959. He retired from the US Air Force in 1971 after 28 years of service. He was a decorated pilot receiving the Distinguished Flying Cross with two Oak Leaf Clusters, the Air Metal with ten Oak Leaf Clusters, the German Lufwafe Command Pilot Wings and the Korean Air Force Command Pilot Wings. Raymond is survived by his wife Betty of 47 years, 2 children, 5 grandchildren, and 4 great-grandchildren. No services are being planned at this time.
