He received a scholarship to University of San Francisco where he played on the last and undefeated Dons football team of 1951. He attend Yuba College where he played on the 1953 Orange Show Bowl Championship Team. Dick served in the US Army from 1954-55. He then attended the University of Utah graduating in 1957 with a B.S. in Business Administration. An agent for New York Life Insurance, he owned his own insurance company for over 40 years and was actively involved in real estate development. Dick married Betty Caffrey Burger on April 14, 1973 in Sausalito, CA. They were married for 37 years, enjoyed many fun trips with family and endearing friends, most notably taking his high school class on a trip to Hawaii for their 50th year reunion.
