Robert Morris Kelly known to most as Bob; was born July 9, 1930 in Algona Washington. Bob spent most of his childhood, growing up in Renton Washington. He graduated from Renton High School class of 1949. Bob then joined the Navy, fresh out of high school he was headed to the Korean War. Following the war, Bob returned home, and he married Nancy N. Haug November 20, 1953. They were blessed with three wonderful children; Debi, Cyndi and Ty. In 1983 from Renton, Bob and his family moved to Kent, Washington for a brief time and then moved on to Leavenworth, Washington in 1992.
