Samuel "Scott" Davis was born April 7, 1957 to parents John Edward Davis, Jr. and Doris Ann Miller Davis at Macomb, Illinois. His family came to Bend, Oregon in 1964. He attended Kenwood and Bear Creek Grade Schools and Cascade Jr. High, finishing his education at Redmond High School. He then pursued many jobs, including Burlington Northern Railroad, the oil fields of Wyoming, ending his career as a pipe fitter with the Plumbers and Pipefitter Union. He traveled the country with his job, making life long friends along the way.

He dies from complications of strokes surrounded by family and friends.

He first married Kelly Paris and they had 1 son, William Randall Davis. He later married Christina Ashmore and they had 2 sons, George Ryan and John Riley Davis. After he retired, he returned to Redmond and re-connected with his high school friend Sandi Fultz Wells.

Scott was a kind gentle man and would do anything for anybody anytime. If you needed help, he was the first one there. He embraced the Indian culture and spirituality and became popular for his leather work and jewelry creations.

Scott loved his 1956 Harley Davidson Panhead Motorcycle that he found in a barn when he was 17 years old and rode it every year. He was an avid rock hound, hunter, and fisherman.

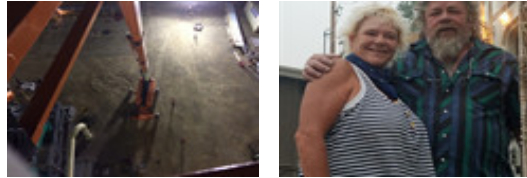

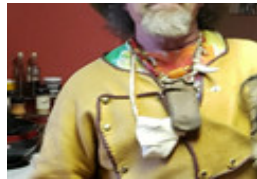
