Bali attends Summit High School and Luna attend Seven Peaks School. Sue always referred to the girls as "my beautiful granddaughters." Sue belonged to a group of the most incredible women who called them selves "Lady Power." Their names are Nancy Conner, Alice Elsoff, Marty Buck, Sandra Miller, Rachel Baker and Kathy Jensen. They met on Thursday mornings to discuss local and international affairs, then worked on a house, garden or community project elected by the hostess. Sue placed importance on education, integrity, honesty and being involved in achieving a clean sustainable world based on understanding, not greed. She taught these principles to her sons and in her later years, to her
